WEED is a performance in which plants are rescued that we call weeds and that are therefore repeatedly pulled out of gardens and parks or destroyed with weedkillers. In the performance WEED, these living beings undergo a transformation into ornamental plants by being dug up individually with their roots and then transplanted into a white flower pot. Through this act, they experience the grafting from an WEED to an ornamental and houseplant. This WEED, refined into an ornamental plant, is then given away to the residents of Seestadt Aspern. They are thus given the opportunity to take care of a living being that would otherwise be left to destruction and to decorate their homes, balconies, terraces and gardens with it. WEED is an attempt to rethink our view of our community of life with all the creatures of nature, which is exclusively oriented towards use and profit, and to grasp their totality anew.
